Auditor's Report

1.0 Introduction:

I was appointed as Audit Officer of Bogra Foundation for 3 fiscal years from 2008 to 2011 as per order no.1806 dated.9.8.2011 of District Co-operative Officer, Bogra I took up the audit on 25/09/2011. Before starting the audit for three years i.e, 2008 to 2011. I served notices to members to get their accounts verified or submit objections, if any, to the Audit Officer in respect of accounts or management. Since the organization is voluntary one and has no shareholders no notice was served individually. This is the 9th audit of the organization. Last audit was conducted by Mr. Md. Atoar Rahman, Dy. Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Department, Bogra.

2.0 Scope of Audit:

Bogra Foundation, a voluntary non-profiteering organization started working from February 1992. The audit of the above noted years was completed on 21/12/2011 on the basis of books of accounts vouchers and other relevant papers and documents as were maintained by the organization and produced before me for my verification and checking. Field level verification were also made wherever I thought necessary. Bogra Foundation's office is located in the house of its Founder Chairman Mr. Anis Rahman.

3.0 Bogra Foundation & its Background:

The Foundation was organized by Mr. Anis Rahman, an ex-member of Civil Service which was registered by the Social Welfare Department of the Govt. of Bangladesh on 29th April, 1993 under no. 436/93 Bogra. The objects of the Foundation are to eradicate ignorance, hunger, disease and oppression in the society and bring about overall socio-economic development of the rural poor, specially women, girls and children.

3.1 Name and Monogram:

As per registered constitution of the Foundation the name of the Organization is in vernacular 'বগড়া ফাউন্ডেশন' and in english 'Bogra Foundation'. The general members in a general meeting approved a monogram prepared by the management on the idea of its chairman Mr. Anis Rahman as follows:

- I. Green Bangladesh map showing Bogra District as radiated golden sun.
- II. The map is within a sky-coloured circle, encircled by white disc and the edge of the disc is ornamented by golden leer.
- III. In the white disc 'বগড়া ফাউন্ডেশন' is inscribed on the top and 'উন্নয়নই আমাদের অঙ্গীকার' on the bottom and in english the vernacular will be replaced by 'Bogra Foundation' –'pledge to progress' respectively.

3. Address:

The registered address of Bogra Foundation is 'Nasimaloy', College Bottola, Fulbari, Bogra P.O & Dist. Bogra, Bangladesh. Phone No. is 051-64766.

3.3 Area of Operation:

The area of operation of the Foundation is whole of Bogra district with a provision to extend its activities all over Bangladesh.

3.4 Membership:

Membership is open to all Bangladeshis not below the age of 18 years irrespective of caste & creed. Admission fee is Tk. 100/00 & monthly subscription Tk. 100/00 only. Subscription for life membership is Tk. 5,100/00 including admission fee of Tk. 100/00 only.

In the last Audit Report as on 30-6-2008 the membership was 104. It included both life members and general members. The membership of 7 General members and 4 life members were cancelled due to non-payment of monthly subscriptions and death respectively. 28 new life members have been enrolled during the years under audit i.e, from 2008 to 2011. Total members as on 30.6.2011 stands at 121 and all are life members.

5. Meetings:

Executive Committee

10 Executive Committee meetings were held during the years under audit. Attendance is satisfactory.

Annual General Meetings & Councils:

Last Annual General Meeting of the Foundation was held on 14 November 27, 2009 in the District Council Hall, Bogra. On the occasion of AGM a nice souvenir was published wherein Mr. Mozammel Haque Secretary, Ministry of Communications GOB, Mr. Swapon Kumer Roy Additional Commissioner, Rajshahi Division, Mr. Md. Iftekharul Islam Khan DC, Bogra, Mr. Mohammad Tarique Anam Dist. Judge, Bogra & Mr. Md. Humayun Kabir S.P. Bogra left their valuable comments speaking highly on the activities of Bogra Foundation.

6. Activities of the Foundation:

It is observed in the records that Bogra Foundation since inception up to the audit year ending on 30.06.2011 conducted a good no. of humanitarian activities in the Bogra District out of its own resources i.e, subscriptions and donations of members, well-wishers and the generous people. Neither the Government nor any donor came forward so far with any donation or fund though it is found in the souvenirs published on the occasion of the AGM & Council held on 19th May 1995, 16th February 2001, 27th April 2002 and 14th November 2009 wherein Excellency President, Hon'ble Prime Minister, 8 Ministers, a good no. of M.Ps, Secretaries of the Govt. including DC, Dist. Judge, SP and Civil surgeon Bogra highly praised of the activities of the Foundation and assured to render all possible assistance.

Examining the records and files it is observed that the management specially the office-bearers submitted as many as 32 PPs to different international donors and the government offices. But no fruitful result the management got. Of the above PPs 'Shelter for distressed women & children' & 'Setting up a cancer detection Hospital' in Bogra Dist. were very much important for the northern region. It is revealed during audit that however, of late, an international donor agency 'Muslim Aid UK' came forward and stood by the side of the Foundation in financial year 2004-2005 though not with a tangible amount. The activities with the help of Muslim Aid in Sariakandi upazila was vividly narrated in the audit report 2001-2005 and 2005-2008. The activities were very much praiseworthy.

Bogra Foundation Paramedic Institute (BFPI)

Bogra Foundation for the first time got approval of Bogra Foundation Paramedic Institute (BFPI) from NIPORT under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of Bangladesh under order numbering *Niport/Kli-Proshi 2009/2749 dated 14.12.2010* for two years' paramedic training of 30 students with minimum HSC or equivalent degree. This is for the first time the Government of Bangladesh decided to make direct paramedics and for which 13 organizations were accorded permission for this training. There are ample scope for employment of paramedics for rural health services.

But BFPI could not yet start training course since NIPORT could not supply course curriculum. Being asked Secretary General told that Foundation will start the training on receipt of course curriculum from NIPORT. A cash account from December 2010 to June 2011 is enclosed.

Other works so far done(at a glance)

Health, Public Health & Population Control:

- I. Medical treatment were given by the Foundation to about more than one lac poor patients free of costs setting up 22 medical camps in remotest villages of the district with the help of its own doctors and the doctors of Bangladesh Medical Association (BMA). Initially the Foundation started two Free-Friday clinics one at Crescent Club, Shibbati, Bogra & the another at main Office, Fulbari, Bogra town which were conducted by the Executive members of the Foundation Dr. Azizur Rahman and Dr. Nurunnahar Rozy who treated about 15 thousand poor patients. Since the clinics were town oriented the management of the Foundation closed those Friday clinics & shifted its services to remotest villages of the district setting up day-long free medical camps as mentioned above.
- II. Cataract operation of 750 and treatment of eye diseases of about 3 thousands poor patients were made setting up 8 eye camps with the help of Dristihin Foundation Dhaka, BNSB Dinajpur & Sirajgonj, ABC Tangail and the Rotary Club of Bogra Town. The operated patients were given medicines & spectacles free of cost and the Foundation bore all the costs of food & lodging to the patients and the doctors during each 5-days camps.
- III. More than 100 Cancer patients were examined by the Cancer Specialists Prof. Dr. Fazlul Haque, Prof. Dr. Abdul Hye, Prof. Dr. Samir Kumer Sharma, Prof. Dr. Latifa Samsuddin, Prof. Dr. Mohshin Ali, Prof. Dr. Dayem and a number of doctors who attended two seminars on “Measures against cancer” held at Bogra as arranged by Bangladesh Cancer Society Bogra Unit under the auspices of Bogra Foundation. After the seminar serious patients were referred to Bangladesh Cancer Hospital, Dhaka for treatment free of costs by Dr. Azizur Rahman, Treasurer, Bogra Foundation and Chairman, Bangladesh Cancer Society, Bogra Unit. So far 103 patients were referred to the Bangladesh Cancer Hospital Mohakhali, Dhaka for treatment free of costs if suspected cancer.

Besides, a number of special medical camps were arranged by the Foundation on urology, dermatology paralysis & medicines in Rafatulla Community Center(RCH) of TMSS where a good number of specialists like prof. Dr. M.A. Wahab & prof. Dr. Maidul Islam, Chairman & Heads of their respective department of PG Hospital and Prof. Dr. M.A. Samad SK ,Director RHD (Pangu Hospital) along with their associate doctors attended and gave treatment to poor patients free of costs. Moreover, arrangement were done for better treatment to 7 poor women by Bogra Foundation who were suffering from kidney problems, gall-bladder stones, maternity diseases etc in PG Hospital & Rafatulla Community Hospital (TMSS). A special medical camp was held at Behar MAM High School, Shibganj on 26.10.2007 where more than 1400 critical patients were given medical treatment by a batch of specialist doctors headed by eminent physician of the country Prof. Dr. AQM Badruddoza Choudhury, Ex-President of Bangladesh Republic.

Health & Sanitation:

So far Bogra Foundation distributed 30 hand tubewells and 71 ring-slab latrines in different villages of shibganj and Sariakandi upazilla specially in schools and madrassas free of cost for drinking water and hygienic way of watering and cleaning bowels. It arranged a good number of meetings, group-meetings and discussions on patha-sova in the villages and even in school-colleges of above upazilla and motivated students and the commoners to drink arsenic-free tubewell water and use sanitary latrines to get rid of so many deadly diseases.

Population Control:

Bogra Foundation since inception use to treat **Population boom** a number one problem. And so its slogan is ‘Either boy or girl one baby is sufficient; if any couple fails to give birth any child-no problem’ when Govt. is yet to officially announce ‘One couple- one baby.’ It also laid stress upon the safe delivery of children to reduce mortality rate of mother and child. A good number of articles on population control and family planning were written in dailies and weeklies by the Founder Chairman Mr. Anis Rahman. Souvenirs and brochures published in each AGM by the Foundation also used to bear the slogan, ‘one couple- one baby; if no baby of any couple no problem’. It is observed that Bogra Foundation is very much worried about population boom of the country. Foundation also seriously condemn & publicize to stop early marriage of boys and girl since it is the main reason for dowry, torture on women and also early death of mother and child. Early marriage geometrically increases population growth and so Bogra Foundation at present is emphasizing its program to motivate parents not to give their babies early marriage.

Upholding Human Rights

Bogra Foundation has a Legal Aid Cell consisting of 7 advocates presently headed by Advocate Choudhury Rawshan Jahan-Secretary General of the Foundation which has been rendering legal aid service free of legal practitioners' fees to the poor specially victims of dowry, oppression by husbands and other members of their families, police victims and to those who are deprived of social justice. Meanwhile the Foundation's legal cell settled 310 dowry disputes, rendered legal aid to 4 police victim cases and rehabilitated 19 immature poor girls to stop early marriage.

Bogra Foundation on 12th March 2005 donated 5 ceiling fans 56" inch each to Bogra jail for the prisoners which were received by Jail Super Mr. Mosarraf Hossain as it is revealed in a thanks letter given by Jail authority to Bogra Foundation.

Education & Cultural development Works:

On continuous persuasion of Bogra Foundation the Education Ministry constructed class-room building in 30 High Schools 75 Primary Schools & 3 Madrasas in Shibganj Upazilla. Besides, Foundation with the recommendations of District Administration pursued Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education, Rajshahi and Madrasa Board Dhaka and arranged set up public examination centers at Namuja High School, Namuja College, Shibganj Fazil Madrasa, Mokamtola High School & College, Gokul High School. Besides Bogra Foundation donated Tk 10,000/00 to Daridaha Girls High School for construction of its administrative building; Religious books worth Tk 10,000/00 to Jamur Dakhil Madrasa with the help of Islamic Foundation, Bangladesh; valuable books on different topics with Tk 20,000/00 to Wood-burn Public Library-the century old historic public library and TMSS library-the largest women NGO of the country.

Sports & Games:

To encourage physical exercise and sports & games Foundation donated sports materials to 4 schools & colleges such as Pirob United College, Behar High School, Buriganj High School and Rahabal High School under Shibganj upazila. Also for cultural development financial assistance were given to Behar MAM High School and Daridaha Girls High School.

Tree Plantation for pollution free environment:

Members of Bogra Foundation so far planted more than 80 thousands trees in different places on their own homesteads and encouraging others to plant more trees on their vacant lands. Foundation condemns cutting of trees by the public and private sectors on unimportant grounds.

It moved to the Govt through an application signed by more than thousand of people of different tiers to excavate all the rivers of Bogra district specially korotoa, Nagor, Gangnoi, Sukdaha, Choto-Jamuna and the exiting canals specially Subil, Sonapura Khal, Bakhra Khal and arrange to keep water there during dry season for irrigation and fishing. If the rivers are well excavated the monsoon will not affect crops of the low-lying area by flood which was also mentioned in the public petition.

Govt. directed water Development Board to examine and take necessary action. Superintending Engineer PWD Bogra Zone arranged a meeting with the Bogra Foundation wherein they said that they excavated Korotoa River from Sherpur to Mohastan. Bogra Foundation expressed dissatisfaction as so-called excavation was nothing but eye wash as digging was 2 feet only in river bed keeping illegally occupied lands of the river unrecovered and as for other rivers and canals they took no action. Bogra Foundation thought that if the rivers and canals are leased out on medium terms to the localities group-wise on cooperative system the people would dig them in their own interest for fishing and using water for cultivation of crops and the looted lands of both sides of the rivers and khals would automatically be recovered. If this follows not a single farthing is required to spend from Govt. exchequer. Rather production of crops and fishes would be increased maximum, people would get abundant pollution free surface water and country's GDP would surely increase.

Road Communication:

Since Bogra Foundation thought that developed communication system is the precondition for all round development it moved to LGED to construct pucca road on as many as 15 kuccha & delapidated village roads of which meanwhile **Boglagari (Shibganj)- Behar-Tengra, Behar bazar- Mondalpara, Fashitola-Daridaha, Pirob-Majihatta- Kalitola, Khoirapukur- Jangram-Kalitola, Atmul- Pirob, Mokamtola-**

Ganakpara- Boriahat, Gangnagar- Fashitola, Mokamtola- Deuli, Amtoli- Gujia-Daridaha, Hukmapur-Mohastan, Buriganj- Satua- Majihatta, Atmul- Bhayerpukur-Molamgari(Behar U/P) were constructed and carpeted. Bogra Foundation's proposal with recommendations of 7 MPs of Bogra to the Ministry of Communications for widening the old Bogra-Dinajpur Zilla Parished Road connecting from Baropur of Bogra Highway bye-pus with Battoli of Mokamtola- Joypurhat Highway to make it a Regional Highway since it is difficult to carry agricultural productions specially potatoes,rices,rabi crops etc by trucks with this narrow 12 feet road.After much persuasion the proposal of Bogra Foundation has been partially considered and only 4 feet widened by the Govt. Foundation is still pursuing for making the road Regional Highway.

Relief & Rehabilitation works:

During natural calamities Bogra Foundation did not sit idle. It made relief camps with medical services to many places as it is revealed from the audit notes of previous years i.e, 2001-2005.No tangible relief works were done by the Foundation during the years under audit. Only Tk. 8500.00 were spent for medical treatment of poors and purchase of books for a poor meritorious student of Namuja Degree College.

7. Staff:

At present the Foundation has one Computer Operator cum Office Assistant Ms Jemi Khatun whose monthly salary @ tk 4000.00 and one Aya cum Cleaner Ms Rupsi Begum @ tk 1000.00+daily food & lodging.Secretary General maintains the office with the help of above personal.

8. Loans & advances:

From the consolidated Balance Sheet as on 30th June,2011 it revealed that there is a profit of Tk. 26,035.00 which is not actually profit since there is a deficit of Tk 3,24,938.00 of previous years as shown in asset side. Out of this deficit Tk 3,38,489.60 has been shown as '*interest-free loan due to members*' as noted in the detailed list enclosed. Total interest- free loan stands at Tk 3,38,489.60 paisa taken from 5 members. The management could not say how the loan would be repaid. Outstanding loan from group members to be realized Tk 36,500.00 as per detail list. Management is advised to realize the loans since these are long outstanding. Learnt from Secretary General that the outstanding are due from poorest of the poor group members of Kutubpur union (Sariakandi upazila) flood affected areas. In spite of repeated tagids management failed to realize the small loans as noted above from 3 destitute women who were given sewing machines on loans after training which now stood to Tk 13,200.00 @ Tk 4,400.00 each and 61 members of 20 groups Tk 23,300.00 as told. It is advised to write off the loan if it is not possible to realize since Bogra Foundation was established for the human welfare.

9. Remarks:

Before concluding audit I should say that the works so far done by the Bogra Foundation are very much praiseworthy in comparison with the so-called traditional NGOs, with a few exceptions, who used to get millions of dollars in the name of the poors. The valuable comments of the Excellency President and the Hon'ble Prime Minister praising the activities of Bogra Foundation in their message in the Souvenir published on the occasion of the Annual General Meeting held on 27th April 2002are the proof of my above comments. The Govt. and the donors community if come forward to assist the organization, I hope, this will surely do better than so-called notable NGOs of the country.
